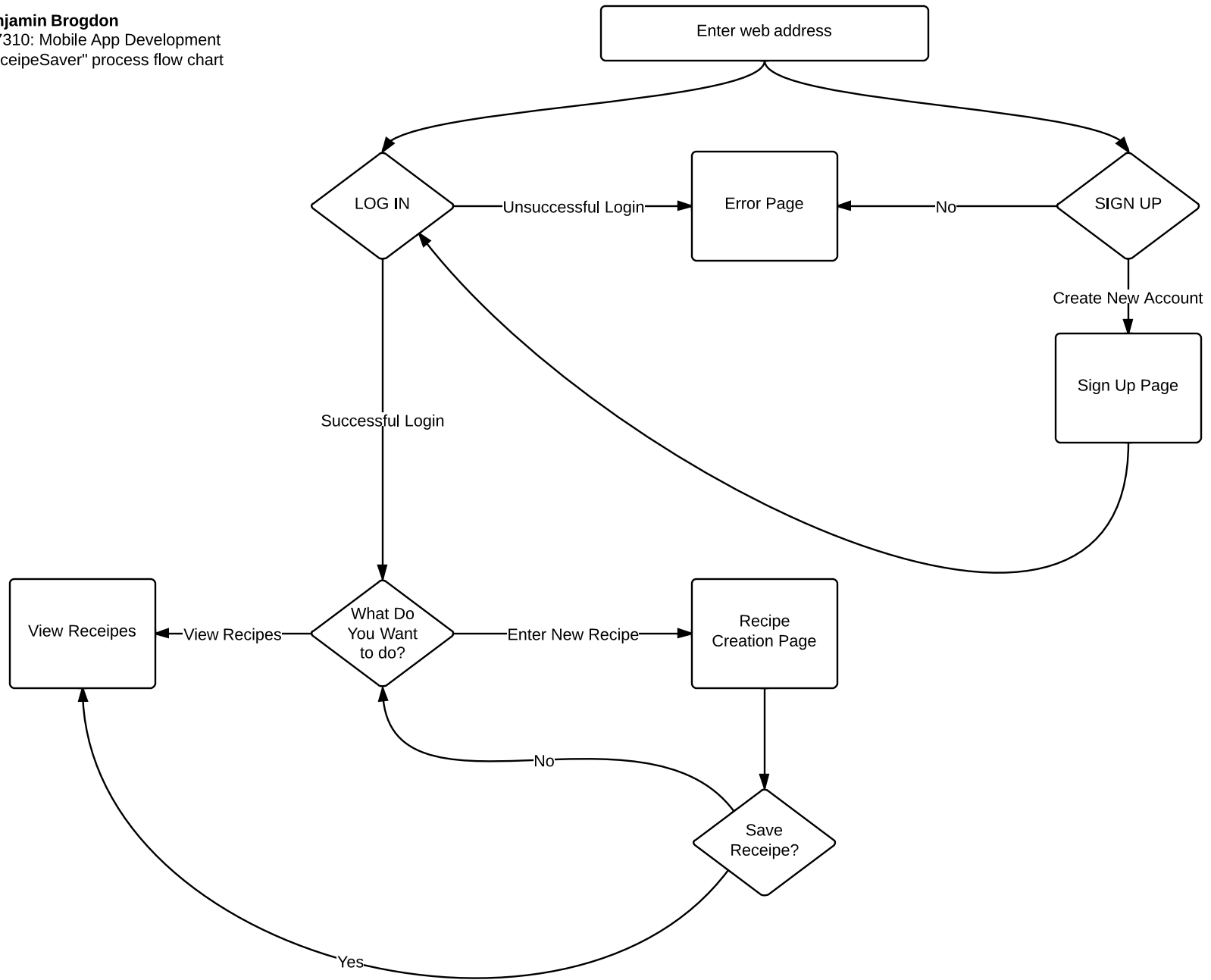

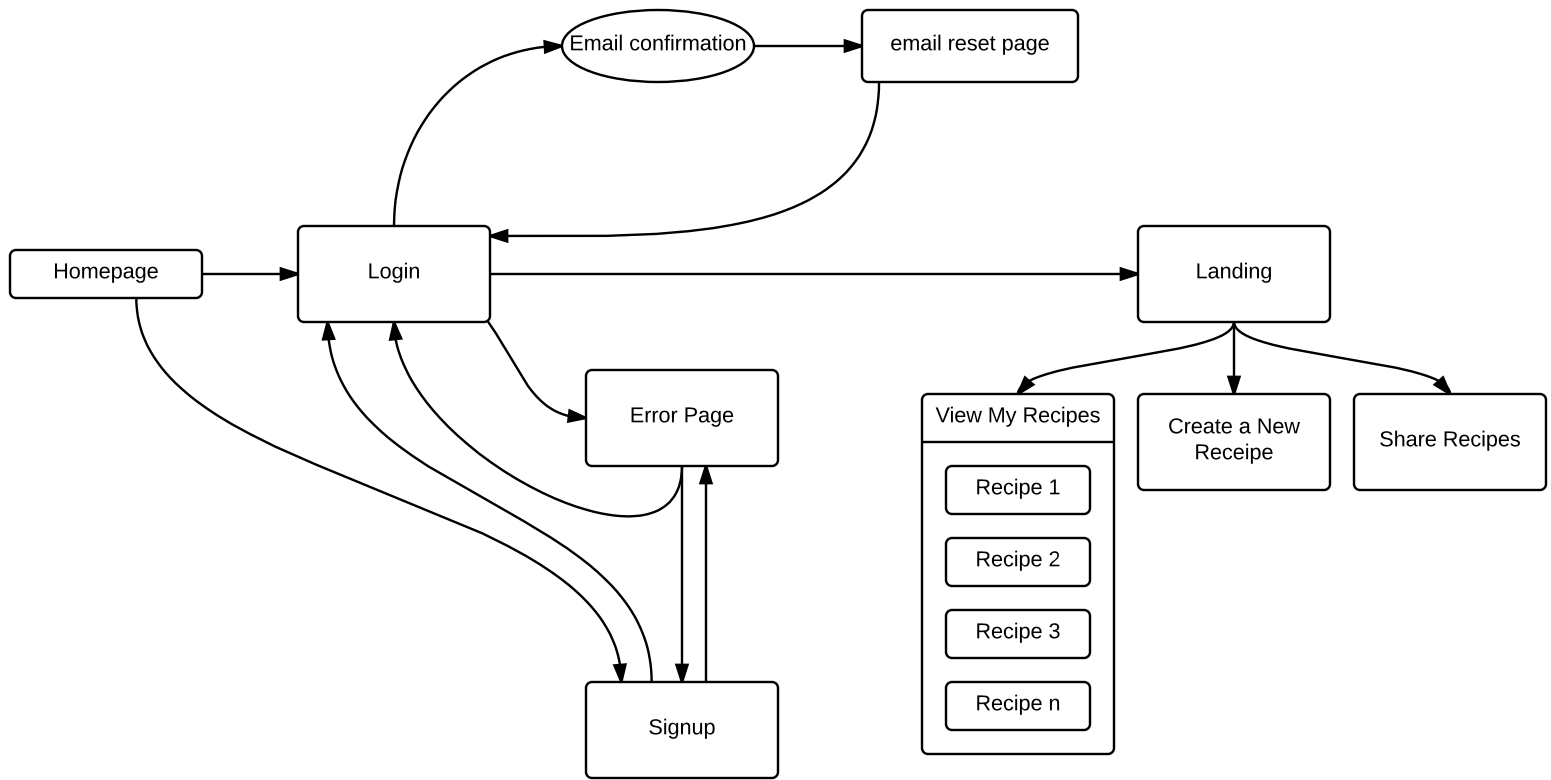
RecipeSaver is a mobile app that is designed with recipe preservation in mind. The interface is designed to be easy to use on any mobile device as users can log in to view their stored recipes or enter their own.

- *What types of app will your mobile app ideas fall into (utility, locale, informative, productivity, immersive or the combination of these types)?* **Utility, productivity**
- *Who will be your target users* **Users who want to collect, store, and share recipes that might be scattered in several places or even in danger of being lost.**
- *What is your context?* **See above**
- *Why will your users use app?* **Users will use the app because they want to be able to access their recipes quickly instead of having to hunt them down and decipher handwriting.**
- *When will your users use the app?* **Whenever they are cooking and need access to a recipe.**
- *Where will your users use the app?* **The kitchen when preparing a recipe, anywhere when entering one**
- *How will your users use the app?* **Smartphone/tablet browser**

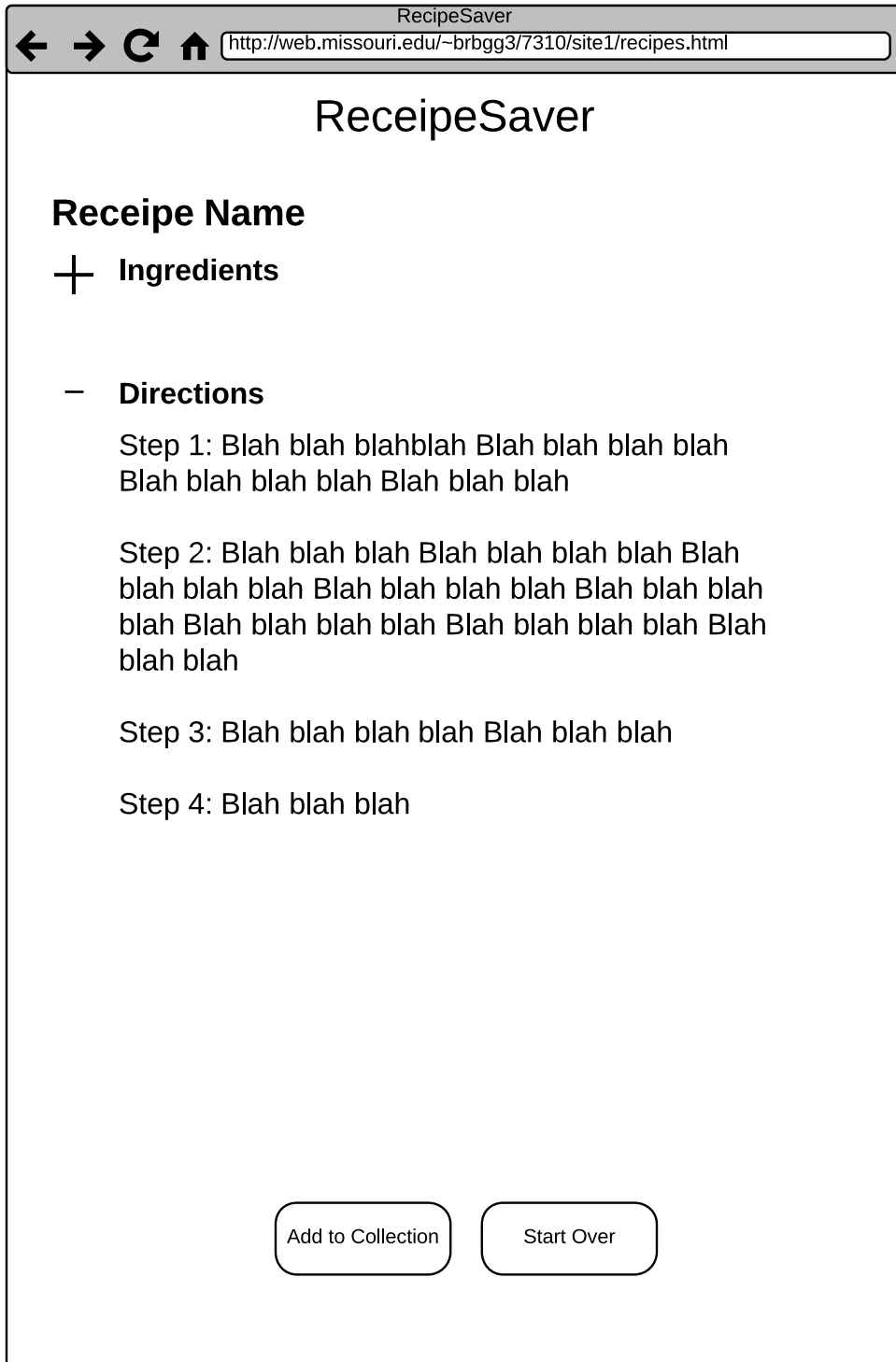

New Recipe page: accordian javascript effects enables navigation. + signs are used to add new form elements. Onscreen keyboard appears for text input. - icons collapse sections. X icons delete the forms element
